We were able to finish the fiscal year with a budget surplus, of that we are able to add \$128,287 to our operating reserves. We were also able to reduce our operating expenditures by \$122,826 from the previous fiscal year. Our operating fund balances will increase from 13.85% to around 18.05%. We continue to make progress in being conservative with our expenditures and recovering financially. Kara will be working to complete the 2018-2019 ASBR for your approval next month.

As you can see, we are projecting revenues and expenditures to be less in 2019-2020. Kara and I will be reviewing the adopted budget and will be preparing some budget amendments for your review and approval. Once better information is received regarding assessed valuation, tax rates and personnel is finalized, the budget will be amended to reflect the updated information. I am hopeful that we can continue to build our reserves once again to a comfortable level. I will work with Kara to go back through the budget and re-evaluate estimated revenues and expenditures and present updates in September or October.

Custodial/Maintenance:

The custodial/maintenance staff has been working diligently to prepare the facilities for the upcoming school year. Cleaning classrooms, stripping and waxing floors and shampooing carpets and putting classrooms back together have taken up the bulk of their time over the last few weeks.

Construction Updates:

Status:

Work on the classroom split units has started with the outdoor units replaced. Curb adapter have been ordered for the roof top units. Lexicon has framed and dry walled the new wall for the secured entrance. Abatement work was completed in this area.

 - o Masonry contractor to start replacing brick on the front at the sign location.
 - o NRG to start lighting retrofit on Tuesday, 7.9.
 - O Start finishing drywall in the new vestibule mid-week.
- Week of 7.15.19

- o Lexicon will install new pass thru window.
- o Heartland Mechanical to install new hot water heater flue.
- o Lexicon to install new roof hatch.
- o Drywall finishing and painting to start at the end of the week in the new vestibule.
- Week of 7.22.19
 - o Heartland to install the ductless split unit in the new vestibule.
 - o Lexicon to complete the vestibule this week.
 - o NRG to continue work on lighting retro-fit.
