Governor Parson Releases CARES Act Funding:

On October 7th, Governor Mike Parson announced that \$61.5 million in CARES Act money would be released for K-12 education. At present, details regarding how the money may be spent as well as how the money will be distributed are not fully clear. However, DESE will be sending school districts guidance regarding how the funds may be spent and how said funds will be distributed in the near future.
